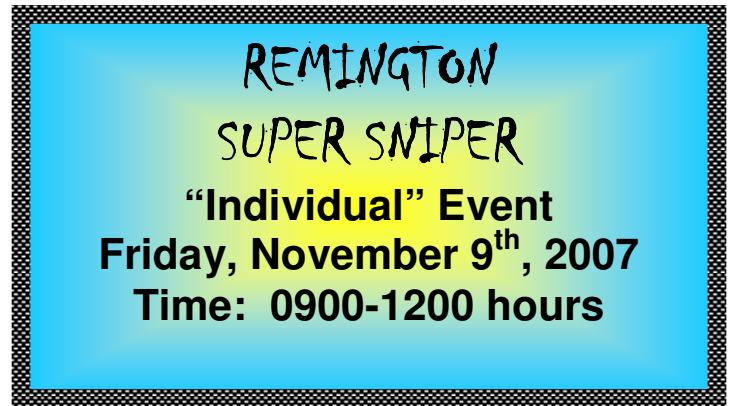


***This “individual competition” is sponsored by Remington.***

**Required Equipment:**

- ✓ Eye Protection
- ✓ Ear protection
- ✓ Rifle: Standard law enforcement sniper style rifle. No rail guns or other equipment not considered practical for standard sniper deployment will be permitted. Any dispute regarding equipment or target scoring will be the sole discretion of the individual event coordinator.
- ✓ Ammunition: Standard ammunition up to 30 caliber. A maximum of 10 rounds will be permitted
- ✓ Range finders: Permitted but ballistic distances will be provided.

**Rules:**

The Remington Super Sniper Competition will be held at the rifle range between 0900 and 1200 hours on Friday, November 9<sup>th</sup>, 2007. To qualify as a participant in this individual event, you must be “registered” as a team competitor or attendee in SWAT Round-Up International 2007.

Each sniper will muster at the staging area ready to begin the event with all necessary equipment. He/she will be provided with the distance of each of nine targets between 30 and 500 yards. On the command to ‘go’, the sniper will proceed to the established firing position where nine metal targets will be indexed. The sniper will successfully engage each of the nine targets with one round each. A maximum of 10 rounds may be fired during the event. The sniper successfully engaging the most number of targets with the quickest time will be declared the event winner and ‘Remington Super Sniper’.
